Strengths of Pupil Premium in school

- Staff are considered by school community as caring and considerate of the needs of all children.
- All staff are able to identify a pupil premium child - using Venn diagrams, school assessment tracker
- Specific focus of PP children at moderation meetings/pupil progress meetings
- Pupils identified as PP had access and continue to have access to the NTP
- Inclusivity for all pupils through personal development opportunities - 11+tutoring, Rock Steady and support for residential
- Outside agency support is used well to support the needs of individuals
- Parental and whole family support is strong, especially for our identified vulnerable pupils

To improve PP our priorities are ...

1. Whole school focus on closing the gap between PP and non PP pupils
2. Development support and differentiation for our doubly disadvantaged pupils - including family support (MAST, EHAT)
3. Ensure PP pupils come to school regularly and engage with their learning
