**Design** (verb) - to make or draw plans for something, for example, clothes or buildings.

**Emergency** (noun) - something dangerous or serious, such as an accident, that happens suddenly or unexpectedly and needs fast action to avoid harmful results.

**Identity** (noun) - who a person is, or the qualities of a person or group that make them different from others.

**Reflective** (adjective) - A reflective surface sends back most of the light that shines on it and can, therefore, be seen easily.

**Tabard** (noun) - a piece of clothing consisting of a back and a front part without sleeves and a hole for the head, sometimes worn to protect the clothes underneath when working

**Uniform** (noun) - a particular set of clothes that has to be worn by the members of the same organization or group of people.

**Vehicle** (noun) - a machine, usually with wheels and an engine, used for transporting people or goods on land, especially on roads
